Explanation of why all of the funds have not been expended.	<p>CUHSD was identified as a Program Improvement Year 3 LEA in 2012-13. As part of its Corrective Action plan, the district secured the services of a technical assistance provider to conduct a thorough needs assessment and assist with development of an updated LEA Plan. The TA provider recommendations included expansion of the schools' intervention programs, acquisition of appropriate CCSS aligned instructional materials, and appropriate professional development. Categorical funds, including planned EIA carryover, were allocated to support the LEA Plan's implementation costs in 2013-14.</p>
