This new 100% online high school will fill a gap in our instructional services by providing a alternative pathway to an accredited diploma, meeting the current graduation standards of the CUHSD.

This school will support retention of students in our LEA who might otherwise elect to transfer to SIA Tech, Freedom Academy, or other virtual high schools.

We anticipate opening on a limited scale in Aug, 2021

- Student Enrollment cap of 60 ADA across grades 9-12.
- Two Certificated FTE/.25 Counselor/.15 Psych
- 0.5 Classified Clerk/.15 Custodial/.25 Administrator
- Co-located at CUAS in Room 7
