- Effective Communicator: This candidate must be ethical, approachable, and courageous; open and willing to be transparent, capable of listening to the opinions of all stakeholders. The next superintendent is a relationship builder, able to connect with people, caring and empathetic. This superintendent will be comfortable whether in a one-on-one conversation or communicating to a large audience; they will be effective in all forms of communication.
