We are pleased to inform you that *Central Union High School District* will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision for 2020-2021 School Year.

Great news for you and your students! All enrolled students of *CUHSD* (*Central*, *Southwest*, *Desert Oasis*/ *Phoenix Rising High School*) are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2020-2021 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.
