1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Currently, Central Union High School District has a very strong Visual and Performing Arts program at both comprehensive sites (Central and Southwest) and is increasing arts opportunities at Desert Oasis High School even prior to Prop 28 fund being available. That being said, through Prop 28 funding, we have increased opportunities in the 23-24 school year though and will be increasing in 24-25 through the hiring of additional teachers. Additionally, CUHSD purchased new instruments, sound equipment, and other supplies to improve the services/offerings in courses that we would not have been able to purchase without Prop 28 funding. Educational field trips to allow students the opportunity to see music in action and see career opportunities in the music industry were afforded to students through Prop 28 dollars as well.
