

Central Union Adult High School School Bus Driver Training Course

To transport students safely in the state of California, the law requires that you have:

- * A driver's license of the appropriate class
- * A Special School Bus Driver's Certificate

You can obtain the appropriate license after you have a medical certificate from a doctor and by going to DMV to apply for a:

- Class "B" Driver's license or (Class "A" license is acceptable)
- Passenger endorsement (P)
- School Bus endorsement (S)

You can have a Special Drivers' Certificate after completing a <u>minimum</u> of 20 classroom hours from the Instructor's Manual for California's Bus Driver's Training Course and a <u>minimum</u> of 20 hours of Behind-the-wheel training. (<u>Behind the wheel training will be provided by the company who hires you once you have passed all written examinations at DMV and CHP)</u>

You can apply for a Special Driver's Certificate at the local CHP office after you have completed the following:

- A class "B" driver's license with "P" and "S" endorsements (a permit from DMV is also ACCEPTABLE)
- Has completed a minimum of 20 classroom hours of instruction for school bus drivers.
- A clean driver's record for the last 3 years.

DISQUALIFIED APPLICANTS:

*Any sex crime

*Any offense related to the possession Or transportation of narcotics Within 7 years .

*Any felony

*Cruelty to spouse or child

*Domestic Violence

*Has knowingly made a false statement or Concealed material fact on an Application for certificate endorsement *Suspension of driving privilege within the last 3 years including back pay on child support

*Involved in 3 accidents within the last 12 months

*Does not meet the minimum medical standards

*Dishonored Check
